

## Microsoft 365 Collaboration Planning

Many organisations deployed Microsoft Teams to meet an immediate need for remote working. In many cases, this also gave access to additional collaboration and productivity services, including SharePoint and OneDrive. These services are picked-up by the business and used in different ways, and to varying degrees. The use and adoption of Microsoft 365 becomes organic, rather than being fully considered and properly planned.
